The **Certified Environmental Access Consultant** (C.E.A.C.) credentialing program is administered through VGM Live at Home (LAH). Environmental access is the process of adapting the workplace, residence, and/ or general environment to promote the independence, safety, and functional ability for the physically challenged and aging individuals.



EXAMINATION CONTENT

The online examination consists of 120 multiple-choice questions covering the six core knowledge modules, principles of design, and practice in the field.

MODULE 1

The Impact of Disease State Progression, Disability, and the Aging Process: Demographics of disability impacting the home and work environment, aging factors, function, and safety issues.

MODULE 2

How Delivery Systems Impact Environmental Access Issues: Legislation, community resources, roles of health care professionals, and other pertinent system factors that directly affect decisions and recommendations by an environmental access specialist.

MODULES 3 and 4

Tools of the Trade: The How-To's of Environmental Access and The Written Proposal: Appropriate communication, documentation, the role of the environmental access specialist, and related concepts.

MODULE 5

Understanding and Reaching Your Target Marketing: Benefit systems, pay sources, and cost benefit analysis.

MODULE 6

Legal and Ethical Responsibilities of the Environmental Access Specialist: Issues of confidentiality, ethical conflicts, legal issues, and ramifications.



RENEWAL REQUIREMENT

Initial certification, earned through the application and exam process, is valid for two years. In order for a C.E.A.C.-credentialed consultant to renew their credential, they must submit renewal documentation of 10 continuing education credits and a \$75 renewal fee.
