We had seen a few potential delays on components but with some fast calculations and quick work, Matt has already adjusted and will keep us on track for the interim as we plan for a more realistic pace beginning the 2nd half of 2020. Our customer service team will be reaching out too many of our customers confirming the timelines and ship dates with all orders currently in production.

As a reminder, all our Residential modeled tubs will now include the cable drain (a lever assist to the drain at the overflow) with a secondary safety chain that can be left intact or removed... no more rubber stopper. Also, the Residential tubs now have a Back and Seat Heater included within the "Supreme" package as well. For the Professional Healthcare, our RK12E / Erie has been especially well received and fits within a price point that Independent and Assisted Living environments are looking for.

As a last thought, somethings I'm working on for myself during this particular time which I use to say to my kids: wash your hands, keep your hands to yourself and keep your hands away from your face. Wow, it's much easier preaching it than doing it... I hope all of you remain healthy and safe!
