

The recent and proposed tariffs on goods imported from Canada, Mexico, and China pose a significant threat to the supply of essential medical devices. These tariffs could lead to increased costs and reduced availability of critical equipment, ultimately jeopardizing patient care. Our industry relies heavily on international sources for many of the devices and components needed to provide high-quality care.

The disruption of these supplies would have a profound impact on our ability to deliver life-saving care. Patients who depend on continuous access to medical devices, such as those with chronic conditions or those recovering from surgery, would be at significant risk. Additionally, the increased costs associated with tariffs could strain the financial resources of healthcare providers, further limiting access to necessary equipment.

We respectfully request that your administration consider granting exemptions for durable medical equipment and related components from the current proposed tariffs. This exemption would help ensure that patients continue to receive the care they need without interruption and that healthcare providers can maintain the highest standards of care.
