**Serology Antibody Tests: (Approximate Reimbursement \$42 per antibody per instructions below)**

**CPT 86769** (Used for antibody tests with multi-step methods. When *two distinct analyses* are performed (IgG & IgM), **86769 is reported on two claim lines** with **modifier 59** (distinct procedural service) **appended to 86769** on the second claim line.

**HCPCS code: U0002 modifier QW (Non CDC Lab Test that uses any technique, multiple types or subtypes) \$51 Another**

**HCPCS code: 0224U (New as of 6/25)**

**Antibody, severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) (Coronavirus disease [COVID-19]), includes titer(s), when performed**

**Blood Sample Collection: (Approximate Reimbursement \$23-\$25)**

Are reported with **CPT** code **36415** (Collection of Venous Blood by Venipuncture) OR **36416** (Collection of capillary blood specimen, e.g. finger, heel, ear stick)

**HCPCS code C9803** billed by hospital outpatient department
