# ATP Prep and Recertification

## Assistive Technology Training Program (ATTP)

## Online Tech Training

U.S. Rehab offers two levels of online tech training, accommodating training needs from day one and beyond. Both Rehab Tech Training course bundles are DMERT approved Accelerated Education. VGM Education is authorized by IACET to offer 2.0 CEUs for DMERT Level 1 and 1.2 CEUs for DMERT Level 2.

**Level 1** provides a thorough understanding of basic medical equipment, familiarizing through demonstrations to identify equipment failure and repair execution.

**Level 2** provides a thorough understanding of CRT medical equipment, including seating basics and adjustments of seating products for the tech, high-end manual wheelchair repair and adjustments, and repair and programming of Group 3 power chairs with complex electronics.

## DMERT Group Certification Program

U.S. Rehab is partnered with DMERT Group, a non-profit certifying body that set the benchmark for durable medical equipment and complex rehab repair training standards through collaboration with the experts throughout the DME/CRT industry. The DMERT Group certification program offers a number of benefits for employers, student candidates, and the industry as a whole.

DMERT Certification includes three build-upon training and certification levels:

**DMERT LEVEL 1:** Basic medical equipment from walkers and manual wheelchairs to hospital beds, scooters, and Group 2 consumer power chairs.

**DMERT LEVEL 2:** CRT manual wheelchairs, Group 3 power chairs, and basic seating adjustments and installation.

**DMERT LEVEL 3:** Technician trainer able to teach and train in community colleges and any other approved training venue.
